- Why did Mrs May give Wilf a present?

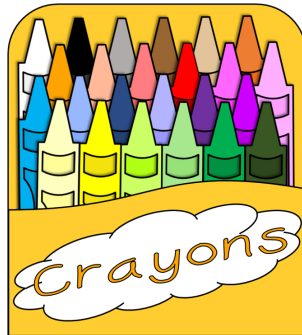

In the story, Wilf thought of a great idea to raise money for the school. Can you come up with some ideas that we could use to raise money for our school?











































































